A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Saints,

As October approaches, and we get into the thick of our officer training, I wanted to give you a clear understanding of our officer placement process. Each July, we ask our congregation to nominate men for the office of Elder and Deacon. Our hope is that you are reading through the qualifications of officers set forth in 1 Timothy 3 and you are observing men in our church who are already serving Christ's Bride in such ways that you deem qualifying.

Once The Session receives those nominations, part of our monthly meeting in August is directed toward tallying your nominations and affirming them together. From your lists, the session selects the men who were nominated the most by the congregation, and who are also the ones serving in various ways, reflecting the office they have been nominated for. The Session will never affirm a nomination of someone who isn't already engaged in the life of the church as an officer should be.

After that meeting, the Session contacts the nominees, they have voted to affirm. Those men contacted after the Session's vote either accept the nomination to pursue officer training, or decline the nomination. Presently, we have eight men meeting weekly pursuing training to become officers at Chapin Presbyterian Church. Please pray for this process. Pray for their godliness, humility, strength, and perseverance. In the days ahead, I will give you a clear picture of what the training process looks like. In the meantime, please pray for us all as we seek to honor Christ and lead well here at CPC.
