Through the Psalms, we are guided in nurturing a heart that continually praises God's name. "Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever" (Psalm 136:1).

May God's blessings be upon CPC as we journey forward with hearts overflowing with gratitude.
