CPC CONCEALED WEAPONS/OPEN CARRY POLICY

The carrying of a concealed weapon or openly carrying a firearm on church property is prohibited at all times under South Carolina State Law 23-31-215 as well as the new Constitutional Carry law H3594. Anyone with a CWP wishing to obtain permission to carry a concealed weapon on church property must submit in writing a request to the Safety Committee through the church Office Manager, Leslie Pollock. If accepted and approved by the committee, the request will be forwarded to the Session for final approval or disapproval. If approved the person will be required to serve on the safety committee.
